Directions to Collingwood

Collingwood is located in Alexandria, VA, on the river side of the George Washington Parkway, approximately halfway between the Beltway and Mount Vernon.

From PG, Maryland (Beltway Inner Loop):

- From the Capital Beltway, take Route 1 South (toward Ft. Belvoir). *The first traffic light is Fort Hunt Road, but the jughandle for a left turn is closed for construction. So, ...*
- At the second light, turn LEFT on Huntington Avenue and follow about 2/10 mile to Fort Hunt Road. Turn RIGHT on Fort Hunt Road.
- Proceed on Ft. Hunt Rd. for about 6/10 mile. Turn LEFT at the light onto Belle Haven Road.
- Follow Belle Haven Road (carefully, speed trap!!) for about ½ mile until it ends at the George Washington Parkway. Turn RIGHT onto the parkway.
- Follow the GW Parkway approximately 3.4 miles to the East Boulevard Drive/Collingwood Road interchange. Turn LEFT at East Boulevard Drive exit (note that this is the SECOND East Boulevard Drive Exit; Collingwood Road is to the right). Make an immediate right, and Collingwood is in front of you.

From Virginia, Maryland (Beltway Outer Loop):

- Although the GW parkway will not be closed this year, construction at Route 1 interchange is messy, So, we recommend the following route:
- From the Capital Beltway, take Telegraph Road South. Do NOT turn onto Telegraph Road. Rater, go STRAIGHT on Huntington Avenue and follow across Route 1 about 2/10 mile to Fort Hunt Road. Turn RIGHT on Fort Hunt Road. Continue as above.
- *From Points South:*
- Enter the GW Parkway via Mount Vernon Highway from Route 1 (just north of Fort Belvoir, directly across from the entrance to Woodlawn). Turn RIGHT onto Mt. Vernon Highway.
- Proceed past Mount Vernon onto the GW Parkway North. Continue about 4.1 miles past the circle.
- Turn RIGHT at East Boulevard Drive exit. Make an immediate RIGHT, and Collingwood is in front of you.
